### *Too Far Gone?*

During the past month we have been preparing to receive a group of inmate/patients at my facility who, due to their crime/sentence, are considered “*too dangerous to be released*” into the community even though their prison sentence may be complete. They are required to receive ongoing treatment, even though the majority consensus is “*they cannot be rehabilitated.*” Beginning in January, we will have an entire floor – approximately fifty inmate/patients who fit this description. There is not much hope to offer this particular group other than the Gospel. I cannot determine their length of treatment and cannot recommend their release. But, I will be able to preach the Word of God to them weekly and teach Bible truths to those who have a desire to hear.

### *Update on Betty*

In a recent letter I gave a testimony concerning a female prisoner named Betty who attended one of our revival services. Betty was bitter, angry, confused and lost. She said that there was no real love between her and her children and wasn't sure if there was a God. Since then, Debbie and several other ladies had a Ladies' Retreat at her prison. As they normally do, they were there


early to decorate and prepare for the all-day event. Permission was given for the female prisoners to begin making their way toward the chapel. When my wife looked up, one of the first ladies there was Betty! She looked again, not because she was surprised to see her but because of the noticeable change on her face. Betty was peaceful and happy! Debbie went to speak to her and immediately Betty told her that she had been saved just a few days earlier! Not only that, but one of her children had been saved also!

### *Christmas Revival at CRCC*

There were 9 saved at our recent Christmas Revival with the Rock of Ages Revival Team. A record 308 patients attended 20 preaching services throughout the weekend of Dec. 16-18 including 4 hours of personal visitation. We had choirs in from two different churches on Friday and Saturday night to sing Christmas carols throughout the facility. One young man who was saved was on the phone the same night to call his step-mother and let her know what God had done for him!
