Why was Paul ready to pay his debt (Romans 1:14)?

Why was Paul unashamed of the Gospel of Christ (Romans 1:16)?

Because of two revelations:

- I. The righteousness of God revealed - Romans 1:17
Faith – “The just shall live by faith”
- II. The wrath of God revealed – Romans 1:18
Fake – “hold the truth in unrighteousness”

I will begin this newsletter with a story that took place in San Francisco, CA. Last year while preaching at Harvest Baptist Church with Pastor Win Pechardo, we met a man who owned a real estate business. I asked him if he were to die right now did he know for sure that he would go to Heaven. He was obviously taken back and baffled. He did visit the service that evening and we have kept in contact since. When we were back in the area, Nadine and I treated him to lunch. We chatted for a while. Eventually I said, “I asked you a question last year.” He held his hand up to quiet me and said, “I know the question. If I were to die right now do I know for sure that I will go to Heaven?” He went on to say, “That question has haunted me this year.” He said that at one point that question had so bothered him that he gathered his agents together to ask them if they thought he was going to Heaven. He said with some satisfaction and relief that each of them felt that he was a good guy and would go to Heaven. I said, “What happens if they are wrong? It is not their Heaven; it is God’s.
